




A revenue-generating Endowment Fund will help secure WMNF's financial future, expand our service to the community, and leave a legacy for the generations to come.

Thanks to a matching grant from Community Foundation Tampa Bay (CFTB), WMNF has an exciting, but limited-time opportunity to have your contribution to our new endowment fund matched. TWICE!

The goal of the Meet the Match campaign is for the WMNF community to raise \$200,000 before the CFTB grant deadline on July 5th, 2023.

Once we reach that goal, the station will receive a matching gift of \$100,000 from Community Foundation Tampa Bay, plus \$100,000 will be set aside for the endowment by the WMNF Board of Directors. This total of at least \$400,000 will then be invested in our inaugural WMNF Endowment Fund.

Socially Responsible Investing

In keeping with WMNF 's Mission and Values, the station will work with our local financial services partner to establish and grow an Endowment Fund guided by Socially Responsible Investment (SRI) practices.

Socially responsible investing includes eschewing companies that produce or sell addictive substances or activities (like alcohol, gambling, and tobacco) in favor of seeking out companies engaged in social justice, environmental sustainability, and alternative energy/clean technology initiatives.



Growing Our Impact

For more than 40 years, WMNF has remained fiercely independent and fiscally sound, operating on a modest annual budget, with a small paid staff, and limited resources.

Largely volunteer powered, WMNF has always lived strictly within its means. Even the state-of-the-art facility from which we operate was funded through the station's own capital campaign, and the loan paid off ahead of schedule.

In fact, WMNF has earned outstanding ratings for its financial management from its financial auditors, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB), NPR, Florida Public Broadcasting, and other oversight partners.

That said, the potential to grow the impact of WMNF's community-conscious, Mission-driven agenda is more important than ever.


